### **Our Community**

Prattville began in 1833 when Daniel Pratt arrived on the scene. Acquiring land at the fall line of Autauga Creek, he established the town of Prattville and began manufacturing his cotton gins. Pratt's gin company became the foremost producer of cotton gins in the world. Prattville is known today as the "Birthplace of Industry in Alabama". Although ranked as one of the fastest growing areas in Alabama, Prattville maintains a quaint charm. Flowing fountains, classic older homes, and numerous new, upscale and affordable neighborhoods are all part of an eclectic blend linking Prattville's past to its future.

### **Our School**

East Memorial Christian Academy is composed of two divisions: elementary, which includes K4-5<sup>th</sup> grades and secondary, which includes 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades. The secondary level is further divided into middle school (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade) and high school (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade) categories. High school enrollment for 2010-2011 was 158 students and total enrollment was 282 students. The school opened in the fall of 2003 and graduated its first senior class in the spring of 2006. East Memorial Christian Academy is accredited by The Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and holds membership in The Alabama Independent School Association.

### **College Attendance History**

26 students graduated in the **Class of 2011.**

26 students continued their education after high school. Of the 26, 15 matriculated to 4-year institutions, nine matriculated to a community college or technical institution. More than \$600,000 was offered to this class in post-secondary scholarships.

36 students graduated in the **Class of 2010.**

36 students continued their education after high school. Of the 36, 28 matriculated to 4-year institutions, seven matriculated to a 2-year institution, one enlisted in the Army National Guard and will begin his education in January 2011. More than \$1,200,000 was offered to the class of 2010 in post-secondary scholarships.

29 students graduated in the **Class of 2009.**

27 students continued their education after high school. Of the 27, 22 matriculated to 4-year in-state institutions, five matriculated to a 2-year institution, and one enlisted in the armed services.

33 students graduated in the **Class of 2008.**

32 students continued their education after high school. Of the 32 students, 26 matriculated to 4-year in-state institutions, two matriculated to a 4-year out-of-state institution, three matriculated to a 2-year institution, and one enlisted in the armed services.

18 students graduated in the **Class of 2007.**

17 students continued their education after high school. Of the 17 students, 14 matriculated to four -year in-state institutions, one matriculated to a 4- year out-of-state institution, one matriculated to a 2-year institution, and one enlisted in the armed services.

15 students graduated in the **Class of 2006**.

11 students continued their education after high school. Of the 11 students, nine matriculated to 4-year in-state institutions, and two matriculated to a technical institution.

## Our Curriculum

The academic program is organized on the semester schedule. A maximum load is seven credits per year. The students receive 360 minutes of instruction each day with core subjects meeting 52 minutes per day and non-core 45 minutes per day.

East Memorial Christian Academy offers two diploma options for graduation: AISA Advanced Diploma, Alabama High School Diploma (Standard Diploma). Twenty-eight credits are required for graduation, ½ credit = 1 semester, 1 credit = 1 year.

Units (credits) toward graduation begin in Grade 9. We award an Advanced Diploma to those who successfully complete the college preparatory track and a Standard Diploma to those who successfully complete the general studies track. These tracks are as follows:
